FIRST AID

Mix Repel-X[®]P Emulsifiable Fly Spray with water at proper dilution. First, put the required amount into sprayer or mixing container. Then, add water according to directions and mix thoroughly before using.

IMPORTANT: Mix fresh solution before each use. Apply with pressure sprayer or sponge it on horses. Make sure animal's coat is thoroughly wet. Use approximately 8 oz, for each animal depending on size of horse or pony. Avoid getting solution into the animal's eyes.

HORSES: To protect horses from horn flies, house flies, gnats and mosquitoes apply at a 1 to 7 dilution. Each pint of concentrate makes a gallon of finished spray. Repeat application every 3 to 4 days, or as often as needed. Where horse flies, deer flies (tabanids), stable flies, ticks, or Deer Ticks, that may transmit Lyme Disease, are a problem, apply a 1 to 4 dilution and repeat as needed.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. DISPOSAL: IF EMPTY: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. IF PARTLY FILLED: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
