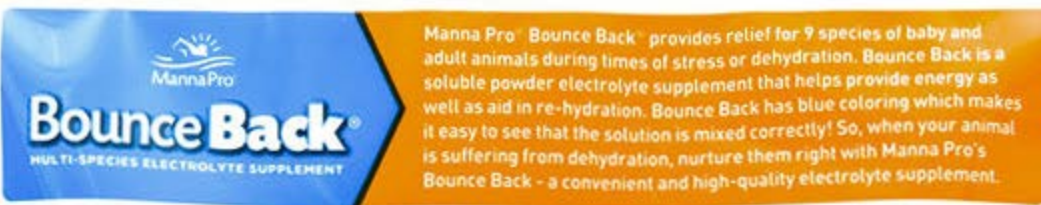

## GUARANTEED ANALYSIS

Dextrose ... min ..... 50.00%  
 Glycine ... min ..... 3.00%  
 Salt ..... min ..... 7.25%  
 Salt ..... max ..... 7.75%

Sodium .... min ..... 5.50%  
 Sodium .... max ..... 6.25%  
 Potassium . min ..... 1.50%

## INGREDIENTS

Dextrose, sodium bicarbonate, salt, glycine, potassium chloride, sodium silico aluminate, Blue 1.

## USAGE INSTRUCTIONS:

Bounce Back is a concentrated nutritional supplement for cattle & calves; horses & foals; goats & kids; sheep & lambs; fawns & elk calves; llamas, alpacas & crias; adult & baby pigs.

Please see the following text for mixing and feeding instructions. When mixing, add powder to warm water and stir to dissolve completely. Do not mix into milk or milk replacer. Do not discontinue regular milk replacer feedings. Discard any unused solution after 24 hours. Store dry powder in a tightly closed container, in a cool, dry place.

4 cups=1 quart; 4 quarts=1 gallon

When mixed properly, Bounce Back should appear light blue in color.

## MIXING AND FEEDING INSTRUCTIONS:

**CALF:** Mix 1 packet of Bounce Back into 2 quarts of warm water. Depending on the severity of scours and level of dehydration, bottle-feed 2 quarts of solution 1-3 times daily between regular milk replacer feedings.

**FOAL:** Mix 1 packet of Bounce Back into 2 quarts of warm water. Offer the solution at a rate of 1 1/2 to 2 quarts for each 100 pounds of body weight, twice daily. Feed from a bottle or an open pail secured at chest height.

**LAMB OR GOAT KID:** Mix 5 level teaspoons of Bounce Back into 2 cups of warm water. Offer the solution at a rate of 1/2 cup for each 6 pounds of body weight. Feed from a bottle twice daily or free-choice feeder.

**BABY PIG:** Mix 5 level teaspoons of Bounce Back into 2 cups of warm water. Offer in a free-choice feeder for 1-2 days during weaning, hot weather or stress.

**CRIA (LLAMA OR ALPACA), FAWN OR ELK CALF:** Mix 5 level teaspoons of Bounce Back into 2 cups of warm water. Offer the solution at a rate of 1/2 cup for each 6 pounds of body weight. Feed from a bottle twice daily or free-choice feeder.

**Note:** Male elk and deer that are bottle-fed should be castrated to help prevent dangerous aggressive behavior.

**ADULT CATTLE, SHEEP, GOAT, HORSE, LLAMA, ALPACA OR PIG:** Mix 1 packet of Bounce Back into 2 gallons of warm water. Feed free choice from a pail during stress or transport. Offer as the only source of drinking water for 1 hour, 2-3 times daily.

**REMINDER:** Feed is perishable. Store this product in a cool, dry area away from rodents and insects.  
**WARNING:** Do not feed any product that is spoiled, moldy, rodent or insect-infested, or abnormal in appearance or odor, as it may cause illness or death.

# 4 lb Bag Feeding Instructions

Please use the following table for mixing and feeding instructions. When mixing, add powder to warm water and stir to dissolve completely. Do not mix into milk or milk replacer. Do not discontinue regular milk replacer feedings. Discard any unused solution after 24 hours. Store dry powder in a tightly closed container, in a cool, dry place.

Animal	Amount of Bounce Back powder	Amount of Warm Water	Feeding rate
Calf	4 level measures of enclosed scoop	2 quarts	2 quarts, 1-3 times daily
Foal	4 level measures of enclosed scoop	2 quarts	1 1/2-2 quarts / 100 lb body wt, 2 times daily
Lamb, Goat Kid, Cria, Fawn or Elk Calf	1 level measures of enclosed scoop	2 cups	1/2 cup / 6 lb body wt, 2 times daily
Baby Pig	1 level measures of enclosed scoop	2 cups	Offer in free choice feeder for 1-2 days
Adult Horse, Cattle, Llama, Alpaca, Sheep or Goat	4 level measures of enclosed scoop	2 gallons	Offer free choice from pail. Offer as only source of drinking water for 1 hr, 2-3 times daily

**Note:** When mixed properly, Bounce Back should appear light blue in color.

**Note:** The enclosed measuring scoop holds about one ounce of dry Bounce Back powder by weight.
