Fitting Your DARE® Cribbing Control Collar

The Dare® Cribbing Control Collar is made of durable leather that is able to withstand years of use. Like any leather product, it will be slightly stiff when new & will conform to the horse as it breaks in. Check & adjust the fit of the collar over time.

The collar should be comfortably snug as shown in the pictures at right when the horse's neck is level or above. The collar is reversible and has no front or back. If you can turn the collar out of position without difficulty, tighten it. The collar will loosen when the horse drops its head to eat, so check the fit at the horse's normal cribbing position. Every horse's cribbing (wind sucking) habit, personality and conformation is unique so the collar may need to be tighter or looser to be effective. Additional holes or half holes can be punched in the crown strap for optimum fit. If collar is not effective, try tightening it. Some very determined cribbers will need to have a tighter collar.
