

Adams Plus Flea & Tick Shampoo

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Important: Read entire label before each use.

Directions for Use: Adams™ Plus Flea & Tick Shampoo with Precor® may be used full strength or diluted with two parts water. Thoroughly wet your pet with warm water. Do not apply shampoo around eyes. The total amount of shampoo to be applied is 1½ tablespoons for each 5 lbs of pet's weight. Estimate the total amount of shampoo needed for your pet, then apply shampoo along the back of the pet. Work well into coat starting at the head and working back. Spread lather to include head, neck, legs and feet. Continue to work lather in over the whole pet for three to five minutes (this is an important part of the grooming procedure). After lather has been worked in over the entire pet, rinse pet thoroughly with warm water. For extremely dirty or scaly animals, the above procedure may be repeated. Repeat every 7 to 10 days, if necessary, for adult flea relief. Flea egg hatch inhibition will last for 28 days.

Precautions: Do not contaminate food or feedstuffs. This product is for topical use only. Do not ingest. Do not apply to pets (puppies or kittens) less than 12 weeks old.

Consult a veterinarian before applying this product on medicated, debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals.

Sensitivities may occur after using any pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

Do not apply more than one time per day.

Active ingredients: (S)-Methoprene 0.10%, Pyrethrins 0.15%, and Piperonyl Butoxide* 1.88%

Adams Plus Pyrethrin Dip

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Important: Read entire label before each use.

Directions for Use: Shake well before using.

Do not use on puppies or kittens less than 12 weeks of age. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply near eyes and mouth.

Apply sparingly around ears. Wash hands with soap and water promptly after use.

Dogs and Cats: To kill fleas, ticks and lice, thoroughly mix one half-ounce (one tablespoon) of this product with one gallon of warm water. For outdoor animals in areas of severe infestations, 2 oz (4 tablespoons) per gallon may be used. Make fresh solution daily. If animal's coat is very dirty, bathe first with shampoo. Dip should be applied to dry or damp (not wet) coat. When diluted 2 oz per gallon, do not apply more than ½ gallon per animal. When diluted 0.5 oz per gallon, do not apply more than two gallons per animal. Sponge or dip animal with diluted product making sure all areas are soaked to the skin. Let dip dry on animal. Do not rinse off. Repeat treatment every seven days if necessary.

Precautions:

User should wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. User should remove clothing immediately if pesticides get inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. User should remove personal protective equipment immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing.
